

### **Information letter according to article 13 of the D. Lgs 196/2003**

By inserting one's own data in the database of contacts, the person interested consents to their use by the Data Holder (La Spaziale S.p.A.), so that the Holder can deal with the received inquiry only and for no other purpose. The Holder will store and process all data, in compliance with all the measures required by the Law.

Under no circumstances, these data will be ceased, communicated to third parties or diffused and, should the occasion arise between the person interested and the Holder of a negotiation regarding any service provision, a new information letter will follow, replacing the present one.

The person interested can exert the rights according to article 7 of D.LGS No. 196/03 (hereunder) by contacting the Person in Charge for the Data Processing at the e-mail address [privacy@laspaziale.com](mailto:privacy@laspaziale.com), writing to the premises of the Company, Via E.Duse, 40033 Casalecchio di Reno, calling the number 051/6111011 or by faxing to 051/6111040.

In addition, the person interested can object, for legitimate reasons, wholly or partially, to this data processing in the ways and procedures stated above.

#### **Art. 7 Right of access to personal data and to other rights**

1. The person interested has the right to get the confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning oneself, even if not entered yet, and to get their communication in an intelligible way.

2. The person interested has the right to receive the following information:

- a) of the origin of the personal data
- b) of the aim and modes for their processing
- c) of the logic used should the processing be made through the aid of electronic instruments
- d) of the identification data of the holder, the person in charge and the appointed representative according to Article 5, paragraph 2;
- e) of the subjects or the subject categories to whom the personal data can be communicated or that can get to know them as appointed representative in the territory of the State, of representatives or appointees in charge.

3. The person interested has the right to get:

- a) the updating, the amendment or, when interested, the data integration
- b) the deletion, the anonymous transformation or the block of the data processed as infringement of the law, including those for which its storing is not necessary for the purposes they were collected or later processed;
- c) the demonstration that what has been explained in points a) and b) has been communicated also for what concerns the contents to those to whom the data have been communicated or spread; exception being made in case the above mentioned accomplishment turns out to be impossible or requires a use of means obviously out of proportion to the protected right.

4. The person interested has the right to object, either wholly or partially:

- a) for legitimate reasons to the personal data processing concerning oneself, even if relevant to the aim of the data collection.
- b) to the personal data processing concerning oneself with the purpose of sending promotional or direct sale material, or of carrying out market researches or commercial communication.
